Spinal cord injuries are not that frequent but almost always are devastating. The National Spinal Cord Injury Statistical Center estimates that 17,000 people in the U.S. injure their spinal cords every year - and this does not include those who die at the scene of an accident. The most common causes of spinal cord damage are vehicular accidents,

causes are falls (31%), violence (14%) and sports injuries (9%). Accidents Can Cause Debilitating Damage to the Spinal Cord




